I’m going to assume I understand your comments, although they aren’t crystal clear.

Rule #1 You should avoid using absolutes (e.g. absolute, nobody, never, always, etc.) whenever possible, unless there’s a very real reason because your argument can be proven false so, so too easily. For example, you say “The west **never** really helps.” Western help has been promulgated and apportioned through its undeniably amassed charitable arms all over the world.

As far as the government goes, the USA was under no obligation to help your sorry asses. By you referring to “the west”, you seem to be implying the USA? As opposed to the current president of the Ukraine, you have never had good intentions to build your communities on sound economic principles, but you are more like leeches that can’t suffice their own parasitic tendencies. You got Szijjártó Péter running around all over the fuckin’ world donating money and making crappy charitable deals on behalf of Hungarians, including donating 2 billion Hungarian forints to two churches in Mexico on the backs of hardworking Hungarian taxpayers. Why would you rely on the west? The USA isn’t very reliable on many fronts and the word “help” can be so convoluted. Hungary has helped the USA in which ways? You have such double standards that the word “stupid” seems too congenial to describe your assessments in this context.

Hell, you still don’t even understand that Mi Hazánk and Fidesz are both extreme left wing parties—the most basic fundamentals are missing in your comprehension of party affiliations and dialogue—you’re stuck on stupid. Come to my classes and I’ll help you understand these most fundamental issues better. Draw me a picture, is what I tell my students to do when they are stuck in this quagmire. Then when we get into the nitty-gritty their map falls apart in a most brutal of ways.

Hungary has always voted for slavery (a.k.a. kings and queens, oligarchs and babysitters and communists and socialists and democrats and social democrats and illiberal democrats and so on). Hungarians still vote for a nanny state, which, according to US principles as stated in its constitution and declaration of independence, is not something it should or wants to prop up. As far as Trump supporting Hungary, he is either naive, stupid, or another spoke in a political agenda, but it’s neither good news for Hungary, nor for America. This is the question. In 1956 the US was probably tired of your bullshit and was certainly reeling in the losses of their soldiers and the disintegration of their own communities and spirit after the belated saving of your sorry asses. I don’t know all the reasons and certainly neither do you, though I do know that Hungary couldn’t do for itself because its military and administrators were spread too thin, far and wide.

Besides that, the year of 1956 was just 10 or 11 years after you Hungarians and the fuckin’ Germans and the rest of Europe tried to take over the fuckin’ world by dominating it with communist and Nazi principles—some of those battles were defeated, but contrary to popular belief, WWII was never

Unfortunately America isn't in a good position because the communists from around the world (internally and externally), now often called socialists or democrats, are relentless in their aspirations for global dominance, managed mostly by controllers, paper pushers who need jobs, and useful idiots. The national debt, for example, is 105% of GDP, which would never happen if the government followed its first principles as described in its constitution and declaration of independence. Contrary to popular belief, the US isn't a rich country anymore because it went the way of Hungarian communists and Nazis (now called socialists of different stripes).
