Boy, are you so far off the mark. Your argument is blatantly false, and it seems that you would know that. Here in Hungary your assessments are prevalent in many circles as well. The propaganda wing here is extraordinary, here in Hungary, like it is in Russia. Russia's economy is smaller than at least 3 US states—probably smaller now—not too many people fleeing eastward, but by genocide and kidnap and rape and torture and death. In Russia today, just a handful of oligarchs control 85 percent of the value of the country's leading private companies, and Hungary is probably doing about the same.

Do you think they've killed the Nazis yet? NO! The Nazis are in Russia, in Hungary, in Belarussia. I have more than 270 links regarding this issue, including from Timothy Snyder, who gave a 25 hour lecture on the history of Ukraine (and the Budapest agreement). Putin said that Ukraine isn't a real country and belongs to Russia, but his rhetoric has changed many times over the years – he controls the media and has shut down dissent. Putin gave his thesis on this topic and has outlined the historical basis for his claims in it—kind of Hitler's rhetoric, don't you think?
